Since space is at a premium on our Wing, when I pack our liquid refreshments, I re-use my empty 946ml gatorade bottles, fill them with ice then fill up with pure juice — one btl per person. If I take gatorade, I freeze it the night before the ride. This will also serve as my ice pack in the cooler bag, too! I usually pack 6litres of fluids for Dave & I. One each of Water, juice & gatorade.


