RIDER EDUCATION

As we all know, riding a motorcycles is dangerous, and bad things can happen in a instant. *The rider education courses are to help us all refresh our skills and help prepare us, so we're able to help ourselves and others.* Dan Renault, Chapter Educator for BC-D had an experience in late fall that reinforces just how important being prepared is. He was present when a

motorcycle rider passed a car (his just repainted vintage Volkswagen Beatle) making a left turn ... and he tried to pass on the LEFT! Well, guess what happened. Dan's emergency first aid training probably saved the riders life. I won't address the motorcyclists behavior (too weird), except to say, he was found at fault and is lucky to be alive (thanks to some immediate first aid).

The first of our Rider Education courses is the **Medic First Aid** course and I encourage everyone to sign-up (for more information on the courses see the Calendar of Events). The certificate is valid for two years, so for those that have taken it in the past, please check your expiry date. The skills learned are useful in any situation. **Riding courses will start in April.**


