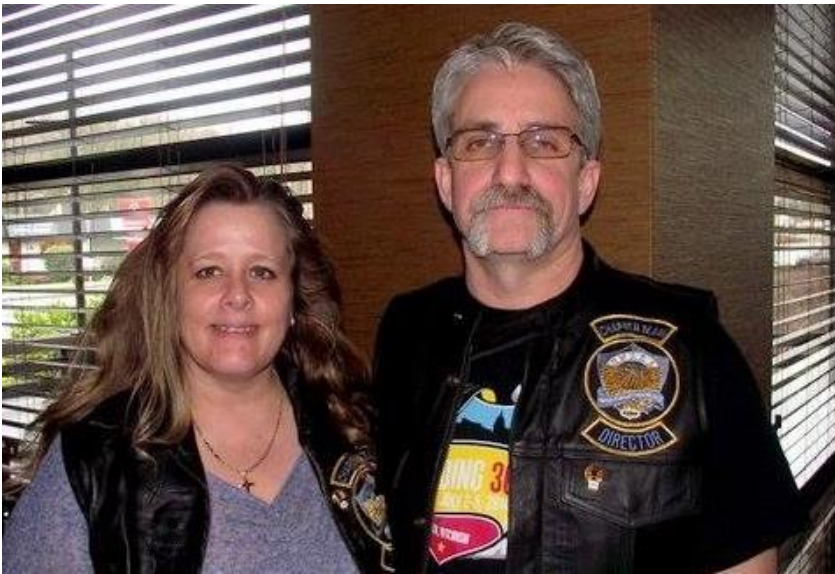




GOLD WING ROAD RIDERS ASSOCIATION

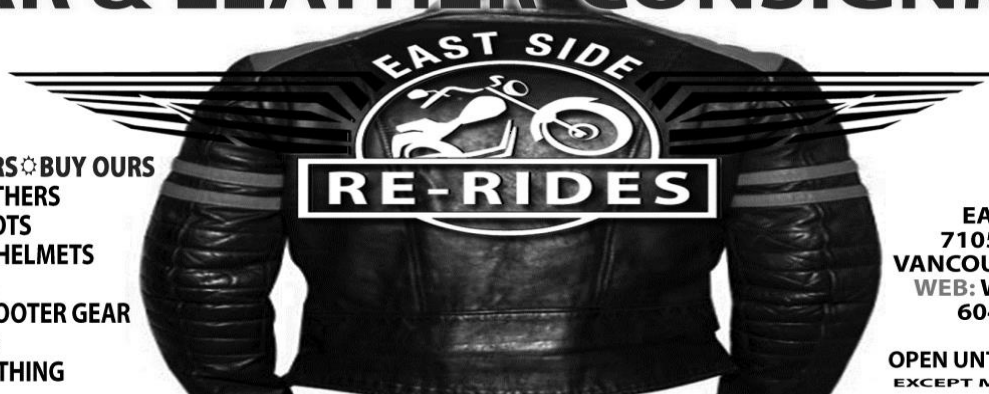
